SHARING YOUR REPORTS

Clicking on “Download” on a subject-level report or a List Details report generates a spreadsheet-ready (e.g., Microsoft Excel) document that you can re-sort, print, and use to share your collection’s report.

You can generate a number of different collection-specific and publisher-specific reports using Ulrich’s Serials Analysis System. For example, you

may create and share reports based on subject area, country of publication, language of publication, publisher, or electronic availability. You can also create and share reports about your collection’s invalid, duplicate, or other non-matched ISSNs for further review and analysis. Ulrich’s Serials Analysis System allows you to download reports in spreadsheet and database-ready formats.
